- Practice that child visited
- Child age
- PCP name, NPI, & email
- Patient insurance status
- General reason for consult
- If known, whether a behavioral health screening was conducted in prior 12 months



## New Clinical Resources for Providers

We have just released a new resource, the YAP-P Clinical Pearl and Guidelines, for primary care providers (PCPs)!

The YAP-P Clinical Pearls and Guidelines will support providers in managing mental and behavioral health disorders in youth. PCPs can use these resources to assess for the presence of mental health conditions and track symptoms over time.

These resources include information on how to assess for conditions, common misdiagnoses, treatment recommendations, and monitoring of the condition. We would like to thank the Massachusetts Child Psychiatry Access Program for allowing us to adapt these resources for South Carolina.
